



Criteria for Attendance at Credition Farmers' Market

Locally Produced

- All produce should originate from within a 30 mile radius of the market, but the Committee is to have discretion on this.

Own Produce

- Produce should originate from the Producer's holding or premises. No bought in or third party finished products are acceptable. Specifically:
 - **Meat:** at least 50% of the animal's life should be at the producer's holding.
 - **Vegetables:** all produce should be grown on the producer's holding.
 - **Fish:** to be allowed at the discretion of the Committee.
 - **Eggs:** to be produced from the producer's own flock.
 - **Dairy and other processed foods, including cakes and preserves:** food should be processed within the defined area from local ingredients where practicable. For cakes no commercial mixes should be used and all ingredients listed.
 - **Drinks:** all ingredients should be sourced locally where practicable.
 - **Plants:** should be grown from seed or cuttings on the producer's premises.
 - **Craft and land based products:** all products should be derived from the land and admission of products is at the discretion of the Committee.

Principle Producer

- The stall shall be operated by the principal producer, or someone who is involved in the production.
- At the discretion of the Committee, Producer Co-operatives and Community Associations e.g. Country Markets. Allotment Societies may be accepted as principal producers.

Product Information

- Information about products should be clearly displayed on the stall.

Other Rules

- All produce should adhere to the rules and regulations of the Food Hygiene (General) Regulations 1970 and the provisions of the Food Safety Act 1995 and any other legal requirements. Full details are available from the Environmental Health Department of Mid Devon District Council.
- The market is a no smoking area for producers.
- Producers must hold Public, Product and Employee (where relevant) Liability Insurance and should have it on display on the stall.
- Equipment used at the market should comply with current Health and Safety Regulations. A current test certificate is required for all appliances used and should be available when requested by the Market Co-ordinator or Committee,
- The market will be open to the public from 10.00 am to 1.00 p.m. Stalls/table/pitches should not close down or pack up during this time.
- The rental of a pitch (2 metre frontage) is £50 for three consecutive months (paid in advance). The rental of a pitch (1 metre frontage) is £30 for three consecutive months (paid in advance)(A new stallholder must commit to a quarterly rent and publicity fee at the outset, unless otherwise stipulated by the committee). Other size pitches in excess of 2 metres can be applied for but are only granted under exceptional circumstances at the agreement of the committee. A limited number of single monthly pitches are available at £30 per month. Some half size pitches are also available. A quarterly publicity fee of £10 (whatever stall size) is also charged on top of stall rental.
- No aggressive selling techniques or haranguing should be employed.

Each producer agrees to defend, hold harmless and indemnify Credition Farmers' Market Association and the Co-ordinator from and against all claims, loss, damage, injury, costs, charges, liability or exposure arising from the Producer's participation in the market. I have read, understand and agree to abide by the rules. I am aware of my own liability when participating in the Market.
